Laboratory Supporting Services to Office Visits

Lab Processing Fee

This aids in the cost of equipment, time for processing, and drop-off/pick-up of specimen collections. Applicable to all primary care and specialty blood draw services, as external locations are also charging fee for service.

Extended time visit, applicable to returning/established patients (not applicable to initial appointments)

Rebel Med NW offers return office visits up to 15 or 30 minutes (for established patients), with initial office visits up to 60 minutes (for new patients). This extended time non-covered service fee is applied to those respective office visits that go beyond insurance covered times, of upwards to an additional 30 minutes. This is to aid any additional time that is required to review educational discussion, treatment management, or axillary services in that allotted time.

Interpretation Lab Fee

Applicable to Diagnostic Solutions Laboratory (GI-MAP), DUTCH, and Genova labs to aid in the clinical education and research performed prior to the office visit, which the return office visit is still subject to \$100 insurance coverage (towards a copay or deductible). Providers spend minimum 30 minutes (upwards to 90 minutes) to aid in the review, assessment, treatment curation, and discussion with any other provider prior to review with the individual.

Income Based Adjustment, applicable for those who are eligible and meet the criteria for our sliding scale regarding interpretation lab fee. For more information, please ask our front desk for the documentation that **\$50** is required for our office.

Specialty Non-Covered Services Agreement

Specialty testing is a great tool to utilize as part of an individual's evaluation and assessment to aid in the curation of treatment protocols. Pending on insurance benefit coverage, not every individual insurance carrier may provide coverage. If and when needed, additional documentation can be requested to aid in any claim for reimbursement purposes. See below for additional details.

The individual will request a superbill and pay at the time of service through the Rebel Med NW facility. If and when insurance coverage is applicable, the individual will be reimbursed on an individual basis through their own claim separately through their own private insurance plan.
